

Brian Hearn has had a love for soccer since age 5. In his early years as a player, while growing up in Furlong, Pa, he played for the Buckingham Travel team. In the summers of 1991 and 1992, Brian earned a position as ODP/state select player for the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association in Horsham, PA. Brian was a 1993 high school graduate of Plumstead Christian School where he was a four year starter and earned many awards. Kutztown University is where he headed to play collegiate soccer, along with earning his Bachelor of Arts degree in History. As a Kutztown player, he was recognized and awarded the Coaches Award for his team dedication and leadership, and for his strong skill and awareness of the game, he was also awarded an Excellence in the Sport of Soccer Award, the last player to ever receive the award. While in college, in 1995, Brian had an opportunity to study abroad and play soccer at The College of St. Mark and St. John in Plymouth, England. During his experience as a “University Football Player,” the team was ranked in the top ten of all universities. After college and after countless hours of dedication to the game, Brian’s dream to play professional soccer came true. It was in the spring of 1999 when he signed a contract to play with the Reading Rage in Reading, PA. Brian played with the Rage for three years, from 1999 – 2001. To this day, Brian still plays games of pick-up, and on multiple indoor teams.

Brian has a plethora of coaching experience. In the summers of 1991 – 2000, Brian had his first experience coaching summer camps for the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association. It wasn’t long after he coached the camps that he was also designated as a Camp Administrator and Coordinator. He also took on the pleasure of coaching summer camps at Germantown Academy from 1992 – 1997. From 2002 – 2003, Brian was part of the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association Olympic Development Staff where he was an Assistant Coach for the U-14 Girls State Select Team, after a few years break he has returned to the ODP Coaching staff.

Taking on a new role from Fall 1998 – Fall 2000, Brian accepted a position as the Assistant Coach for the Boys’ Varsity Soccer Team for Central Bucks West High School. Along with coaching the boys in the fall, he also assisted in coaching the CB West Girls’ Varsity Soccer Team from Spring 1999 – Spring 2004. One of Brian’s proudest moments of coaching high school soccer was when the CB West Girls’ team won the 2003 State Championship. According to the USA Today poll, that year, the team was ranked 12th in the country. This past fall, Brian was the Assistant Coach for the Boys’ Varsity Soccer Team at Central Bucks South High School.

As the former technical director/director of coaching for the Lenape Valley/PA Rush Soccer Club, Brian is still currently involved with the club as a coach and trainer. The Lenape Valley/PA Rush Soccer Club has had Brian on board coaching as Team Trainer from 1998 – the present time. He has also been the Lenape Valley Soccer Club/PA Rush Player Development Program Trainer since the beginning of the program in the Fall of 2005. Brian has also served as Player Development Coordinator for the Deep Run Soccer Club from 2007 thru 2009.

Along with Brian's experiences as both a player and a coach, he is highly qualified with the following: a NSCAA National Youth Diploma, a USSF National C License, and several state coaching qualifications. He is also a member of NSCAA and the U.S. Soccer Federation.

As a soccer coach, team trainer, and club coordinator, Brian hopes to continue to take his experiences as a player and coach to instill the love and passion that he has for the game of soccer in the children and youth of today. Above all, through his enthusiasm for the game, he hopes for and wants all who play to "have fun" with the beautiful game.
